



Class suspension arrangements for upper respiratory tract infections (2A, 3A, 4B, 6B) and other special arrangements

Dear parents:

Several students in this school have symptoms of upper respiratory tract infection (for example: runny nose, cough or fever), the school has notified the Centre for Health Protection. As instructed by the Center for Health Protection, on account of students' health, classes of 2A, 3A, 4B and 6B will suspend for 3 school days starting from tomorrow. The arrangement is as follows:

1. Suspension arrangements
Classes suspended: 2A,3A,4B,6B
Classes suspension date: November 13, November 16 and November 17 (Friday, Monday and Tuesday)
Specimen Collection to Test for COVID-19 arrangement:
Further notice will be announced about the date to collect the test bottle
2. P.1-P.5 test will be postponed to November 25-27 (Wednesday to Friday)
3. P.6 examination (Maths and General Studies) will be postponed to November 20
4. Class 6A follows the normal schedule on November 13. Class is from 8:15a.m. to 1:00p.m. Please bring the books and homework.
5. Remedial classes and sunshine classes will be suspended from November 16 to November 20
6. 333 Learning Companion Leadership Program is suspended for 5 days (November 11 to November 13 and November 16, November 17)
7. Ready to learn English courses will be suspended for 7 days (November 11 to November 13, November 16 to November 18 and November 25)
8. Parents' Day was originally scheduled from November 25th to November 27th and will be postponed until further notice
9. Parents of 2A, 3A, 4B and 6B are requested to pick up their homework at school from 4pm to 5pm on November 13

The school has strengthened the cleaning and disinfection work in the school according to the instructions of the Center for Health Protection. The school hereby urges all parents to follow the health guidelines of the Centre for Health Protection and take appropriate preventive measures to prevent coronavirus disease.
